There are enough loading and unloading zones right next to the dealer area. Please note the access times and rules for the hall further down in the letter.

Visitors will receive a **folding flyer** with the list of exhibitors (name, stand number, place of residence).

The International Mineral Days also offer attractive offers for the whole family:

For big and small visitors there is an active competition and accompanied stone processing with beautiful minerals and fossils. 





## Show regulations

Version 2.00 August 2023

1.	Place Registration	Registrations received after the registration deadline can only be considered if there are still free places available.		
2.	Reservation expiry	Reservations that have not been paid within 30 days of receipt of the invoice will expire after a single reminder.		
3.	Allocation of space	This is based on the quality of the exhibits. Minerals and fossils have priority, as do unset gemstones and high-quality jewelry, over other cut materials		
4.	Stone jewelry Ornaments	Approved if the proportion of stone is dominant and the production is of an artisanal nature and of impeccable quality		
5.	Material declaration	Each object sold must be accompanied by a find label or a material declaration, which should contain the following information:		
		for Minerals: Correct mineral name (internationally recognized) Origin / locality, price		
		for any ground material Correct mineral name or designation according to the current CIBJO standard, also genuine / natural or reconstructed or doublet or triplet, origin / locality, price, company. Misleading fancy names are strictly forbidden.  Metal parts on jewelry according to their composition e.g. 750 gold, silver-plated, etc.		
6.	Additional declaration	Exhibits that have been treated in any way, e.g. glued, repaired, conserved, embellished, polished etc. must be clearly labeled accordingly.  Surrounded or embedded fossils or collages must be clearly identified as such.		
7.	Precious metals	Exhibits containing silver, gold or other precious metals must be stamped correctly in accordance with the regulations of the Federal Precious Metals Control.		
8.	Prohibitions	Artificial, synthetic or colored minerals/fossils/precious stones, as well as plastic casts of fossils, mounted minerals/fossils, products from irradiation processes, recent shells and corals (foam corals), pearls, ivory, as well as pure souvenir items and objects from mass production, objects without mineral content and reference to a mineral show, gemstone imitations, recolored objects. Crystals with artificial surfaces added by subsequent cutting. Cult and occult objects, as well as purely esoteric material. Bath and food salts (e.g. also Himalayan salt)  Flower vases and the like with less than 50% minerals/fossils  The range of healing stones is subject to certain restrictions, e.g. pronounced massage stones or other objects of a non-exhibition aspect are excluded from sale. Mineral preparations in the form of ointments and for oral application are also prohibited. The material declaration according to Zf.5 and 6 also applies without restriction to healing stones.  Prohibited material may also not be used as decoration.  All regulations for the protection of species (plants) must be observed.		
9.	Responsibility	In any case, the stand owner assumes full personal responsibility for himself and his stand personnel for all activities related to the sale. Violations of the show regulations will be punished.		
10.	Stand Lighting	Lamps that change the color of the exhibits or intensify them in an unnatural way are prohibited.		
11.	Sales Discounts	Sell-out practices with wholesale discounts and modified price labels are prohibited. Price tags only have one price.		
12.	Restrictions	Salt lamps, stone trees max. 3 pieces per meter		
13.	General	Spaces that are not occupied two hours after the start of the exhibition will be filled again. Exchanging places, subletting and leaving the exhibition early without the consent of the exhibition management are not permitted.  Insurance coverage is the responsibility of the exhibitor; the exhibition management declines all liability.  The prices of all goods displayed and offered for sale on the table and in the showcases must be clearly visible.
